Letter from the Founder and Director

Dear Partners of AIPM

I greet you all in the blessed Name of Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior.

It is a great joy to have the opportunity to share about the ministry of AIPM during the Ethiopian New Year (2018 EC). Ethiopians celebrated the New Year on September 11, 2025. I would like to thank you all on behalf of the AIPM family for your prayers and sacrificial financial support, which you have invested in God's mission.

We thank our mighty God for His hand moving so powerfully through AIPM. The missionaries sent out by AIPM are able to work safely all over the country by the grace of God and His mercy. God is protecting them as they work in very unsafe and unstable conflict zones. Praise God! We are grateful for His protection and provision during this time.

Last year, beginning from September 2024 up to the end of August 2025, AIPM missionaries presented the gospel to over 160,640 people. This tremendous work was accomplished through one-to-one evangelism, and as a result, over 12,770 people accepted Jesus Christ as their personal Savior. Most of them have begun discipleship classes and were able to graduate successfully.

Additionally, last year, AIPM missionaries planted over 470 new house churches. These churches are steadily growing in their communities. We have also added 115 new missionaries to the field and presently have over 80 new missionary candidate applications in our office. God is moving in the hearts of so many. We see men and women lining up to be sent out as missionaries with AIPM.

May God Almighty receive all the Glory for what He is doing for the sake of the salvation of souls and Kingdom expansion in Ethiopia and beyond.

Letter from the Founder and Director

Ethiopia has over 130 million people, yet only 30 million are professing followers of Christ. That leaves more than 100 million people who are not yet professing the Lordship of Jesus Christ. Therefore, the harvest is plentiful, but the workers are very few. We need your prayer and financial support now more than ever.

Many thousands of students from Ethiopian Universities have completed mission training and are powerful tentmakers all over Ethiopia. Some of them will be sent out as short-term and full-time missionaries. The response from these young people towards local, national, and global missions was beyond imagination.

It is marvelous in our eyes.

Since the formation of Dr. Desta Langena Foundation (DDLDF) in 2023, God has done amazing things. Most recently, in September 2025, we cared for nearly 3000 orphans and the children of widows by supplying notebooks and pens to the children who wouldn't have had the ability to obtain these materials without this support. This was such a fantastic experience! These children are in such desperate need of so many things. These items were a tremendous blessing to them and the community. DDLDF wants to extend deep appreciation and thanks to Ingrid Olson, the Founder and Director of "Partners With Ethiopia (PWE)." Ingrid, along with many of you, has supported the DDLDF to help these needy children go to school. We are eternally grateful.

Another tremendous blessing for DDLDF was on Meskel Day (September 27). Meskel Day is much like "Thanksgiving Day" in the United States. Families gather and enjoy a festival-like day all across the country. Sadly, so many are poor and unable to celebrate due to extreme poverty. So instead of being a day of celebration, for many, Meskel Day is a day of sadness. This year, however, and Praise the Lord, the DDLDF was able to slaughter a fattened ox and distribute the meat to over 65 of the poorest families (300 people). This was a wonderful time of thanksgiving for these families.

Last year, AIPM hosted the most significant training event we've ever had, with 400 missionaries attending our fall training event. This year, we plan to host even more, with over 500 missionaries attending this important event. Thank you to Bay Leaf Baptist Church and others who have made significant sacrifices to make this vital training possible. From October 5-11, 2025, 500 of our missionaries will receive training, enjoy fellowship, and most importantly unite in earnest prayer. This is a vital time for AIPM each year, and we are grateful that AIPM can host the training again.

We thank God for you and all His great blessings on AIPM. May God receive all the Glory for everything, and may He bless you all richly and mightily!!

MISSIONARY TADESSE CHANE & FAMILY



My name is Tadesse Chane. I serve in the Amara Region, in eastern Gojjam, in the town of Bichena Woreda. I am married and a father of 2 children.

For years, I was a priest in the Orthodox Church and also served as its chairman. I used to be very hostile towards Christians. My responsibility as a priest was to protect my religion from Christian movements. I remember one time when a Christian preacher in my town and I chased them away and threatened to burn down their homes and damage their crops. This was the only thing I knew to do. After several years of this type of hostility towards Christians, one

night I heard a voice in my dream. The voice said, “As Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of Man be lifted up.” I wasn’t sure what to think of this voice and this message. I had hoped the voice would go away, but I heard the same message repeatedly, which greatly disturbed my spirit, and I lost my peace. I was so troubled and felt alone because I had no one to talk to about the voice that kept returning in my dreams. One day, I encountered a son of one of the Christian families whom I had previously chased and persecuted. I wanted to ask him about the voice I heard, and thought maybe he could help me understand what I was hearing. I tried to talk to him; however, he doubted me and was unwilling to speak with me. He expected me to do the same thing I had done to his family before; however, I continued to ask him to talk to me. Finally, he allowed me to speak to him and tell him about my dream. He explained that my dream referenced the Old Testament and the verse in John 3:14. I was amazed. I am a priest, but I had never heard these verses before. At that very moment, I decided to repent and follow Jesus Christ. I then got baptized at a local church and started underground mission work to other priests and people in my church.

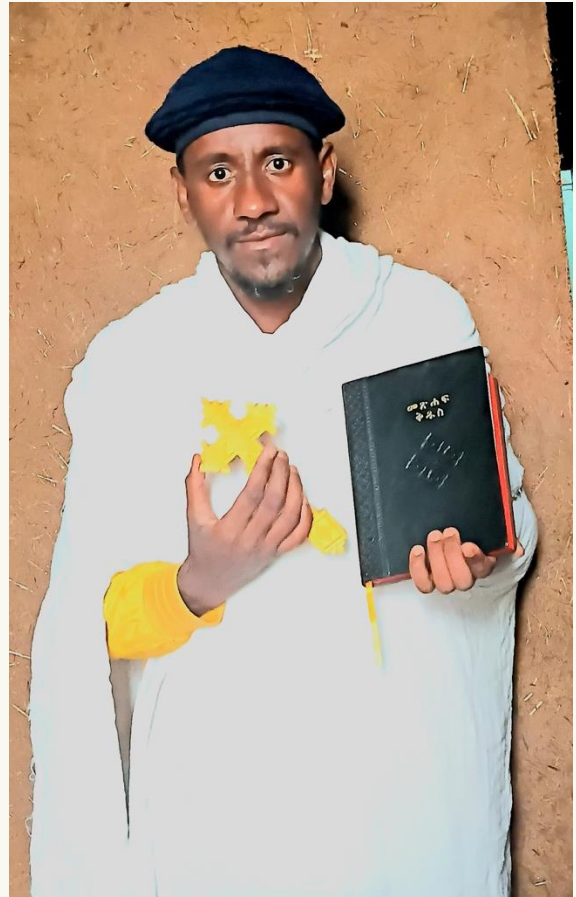

After seven years of ministry, the Orthodox Church suspended me from the church and warned the local church to cease. Then I spoke out about what they were doing to me. The Orthodox church started persecuting my local church, and my heart was so sad that this was happening because of me. I restarted the underground ministry in another Orthodox Church.

Over the next two years, more than 3,000 people heard the good news of Jesus Christ through house-to-house preaching, one-on-one conversations, and various Orthodox gatherings. God be the glory, more than 1,000 people came to Christ. Most of these new believers were priests. Others were deacons, high school students, farmers, and their families. Praise the Lord, God is helping us.

May there be more prayers for this area, and may God bless you.
